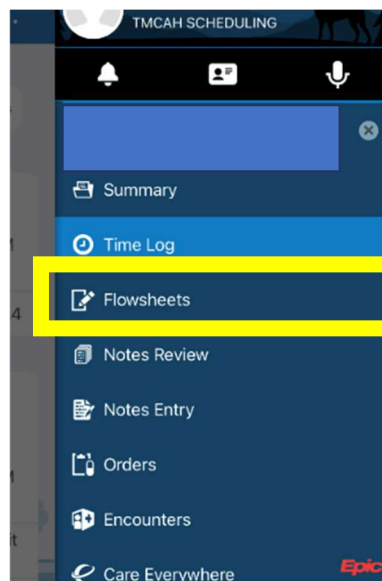
Importing Wound/Ostomy Documentation from the Hospital

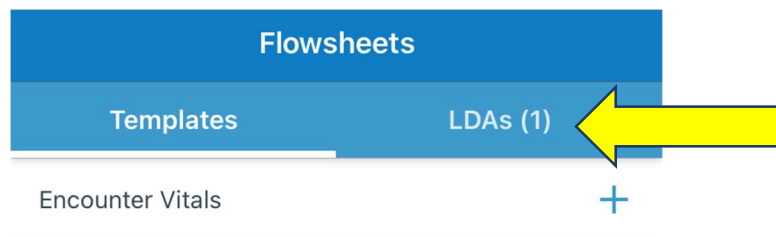
Patients from EPIC inpatient hospitals/wound clinics/MD offices should already have the wound listed on the patient chart if it was present. You should not have to enter new wounds on Remote Client unless the wound occurs while they are on service, or if the patient is not seen by other services who use our EPIC EMR.

To pull the wounds over into Remote Client:

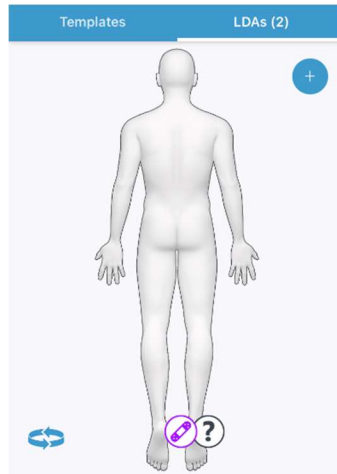
1. Start with ROVER -Select the specific patient in ROVER from your schedule
2. Open the visit you are going to do on that patient by starting with your Time Log
3. Go to Flowsheets from the Epic button



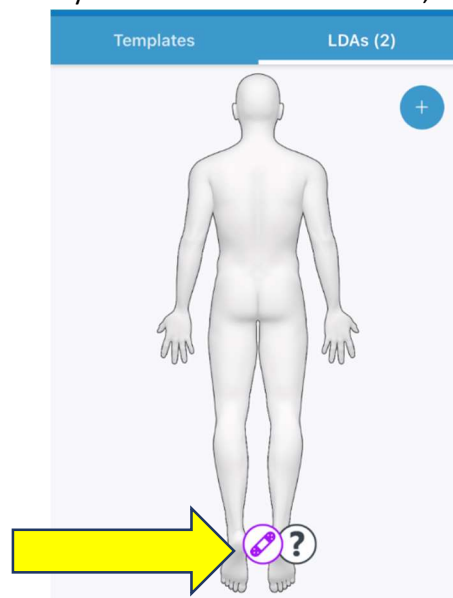
4. Go into LDAs



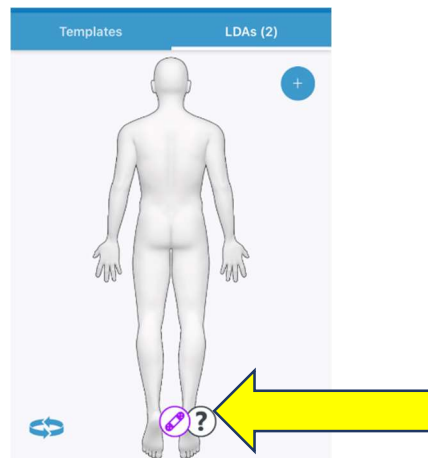
5. See picture of person



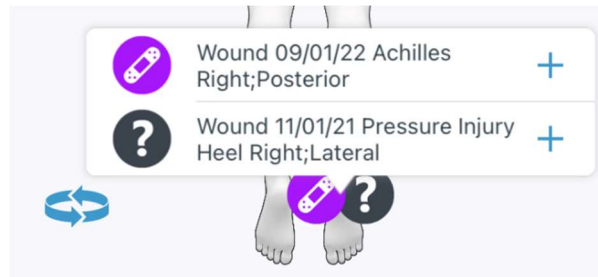
6. If the wound has been entered by a source other than TMCAH, a BAND-AID icon is present



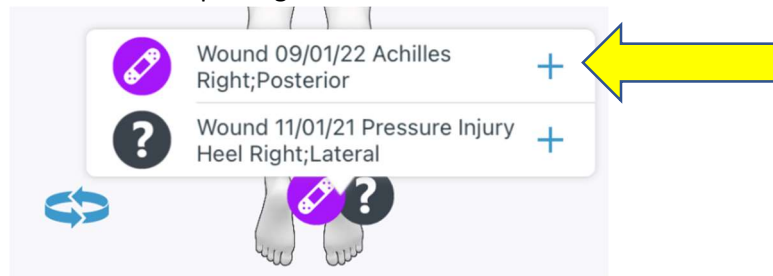
7. If there is a QUESTION MARK is present – that is a wound TMCAH has entered



8. Tap on the BAND-AID ICON and a dialog box pops up



9. Tap on the dialog box and click the plus sign



10. Document the wound assessment and include an image

12. When you are finished with the visit and ready to go into Remote Client to complete your documentation

OSTOMY

The process is the same EXCEPT for Step #5 – the Ostomy will have the DRAIN icon to represent the stoma.
