

# EpicEdge Tips & Tricks

## New Event Type of RPM Discharge

For improved accuracy in tracking the remote patient monitoring program, we have added a new Event Type of "RPM Discharge" that should be used to document the discharge date for all RPM episodes. This means there will be a two-step process to discharging patients from the RPM program:

1. Document the RPM Discharge in the Episode Events section as shown in the screenshot.
2. Discharge the actual episode from the Episodes of Care section (the way patients are typically discharged).
