

## **INPATIENT HOSPITAL SERVICES** (1995 Guidelines)

## **Initial Hospital Care**

(Documentation must support all 3 key elements<sup>1</sup>)

Code	History	Physical Exam <sup>3</sup>	Decision Complexity <sup>1</sup>	Counseling/ Coordination of Care – Visit Time <sup>2</sup>
99221 Detailed Hx & Exam (problem(s) are of low severity)	CC; HPI (4+); ROS (2-9); PFSH (1:3)	Extended exam 2-7 Body areas/Organ systems	Straightforward or low	30 minutes
99222 Comprehensive Hx & Exam (problem(s) are of mod. severity)	CC; HPI (4+); ROS (10); PFSH (3)	Gen'l Multisystem 8+ Organ Systems	Moderate	50 minutes
99223 Comprehensive Hx & Exam (Problem(s) are of high severity)	CC; HPI (4+); ROS (10); PFSH (3)	Gen'l Multisystem 8+ Organ Systems	High	70 minutes

## **Subsequent Hospital Care**

(Documentation must support 2 of the 3 key elements)

Code	History	Physical Exam <sup>3</sup>	Decision Complexity <sup>1</sup>	Counseling/ Coordination of Care – Visit Time <sup>2</sup>
99231 Problem Focused Hx. & Exam (patient is stable, recovering or improving)	CC; HPI (1-3)	Limited exam of 1+ Body Areas/Organ Systems	Straightforward or low	15 minutes
99232 Expanded Problem Focused Interval History/EPF exam (Patient is responding inadequately to treatment or has developed a minor complication)	CC; HPI (1-3); ROS (1)	Limited exam of 2-7 Body Areas/Organ Systems	Moderate	25 minutes
99233 Detailed Interval Hx. Detailed Exam (patient is unstable or has developed a significant new problem)	CC; HPI (4+); ROS (2-9);	Extended exam of 2-7 Body Areas/Organ Systems	High	35 minutes

Two of the following must meet or exceed the requirements for the level chosen:
 Number of Diagnoses and/or Management Options

- 2. Amount and/or Complexity of Data to be Reviewed
- 3. Risk of Complications and/or Morbidity or Mortality

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Time should only be used to choose the level of service when the visit consists <u>predominantly</u> (>50%) of counseling or coordination of care
