





Adding Widgets & Creating Views



Creating a View from Scratch

 To add a brand new view or add an individual widget, click on the tabs at the top of the Dashboard page!








Understanding & Setting Parameters



Overview

- Multiple parameters are available to customize each widget
- Understanding each of these parameters will help you tailor the hospice dashboard to meet your specific needs



Notes

Select the data type and metric you wish to report on. SHP recommends updating the title based on your metric selection.


HIS metrics include eligible patients with complete data and are based on discharge date. CAHPS metrics are based on sample month. Note that there can be up to a four month lag between patient sampling and receipt of returned surveys.

The ending month is the current month. Trended arrows are based on the linear score of the data in the selected time period, green arrows reflect a greater than 2% improvement, red reflect a greater than 2% decline.

Widget drills-down to the Scorecard report.

Data Type

- Data Type will allow you to select which level of accountability you would like to configure
- You can select from 11 different Data Type grouping options on the Scorecard widget





Parameters: Metric

- There are 22 different and CAHPS HQRP metrics that can be configured in the widget
- Note: If you reconfigure the widget to show a different metric, be sure to rename the widget in the "Title" box to reflect the new settings


Combined Metrics

HQRP: Overall Score	Composite score composed of the HIS & CAHPS measures
	that contribute to the three HQRP Rollup scores. This
	includes the seven HQRP HIS admit measures, the two visit
	measures, and the eight CAHPS measures



Parameters: Date Range


- The Date Range parameter controls the "Score" column on the widget
- Whichever value is selected in the parameter will be reflected in the 2nd and 4th columns on the widget





Parameters: Minimum Data Threshold


- The Minimum Data Threshold parameter is used to eliminate data rows (e.g. – Case Managers) that have low or sparse volumes of data from month-to-month
- The value selected in this parameter indicates the minimum number of HIS assessments or CAHPS Hospice surveys per month that will be required or order for a value to be included in the widget results (e.g. – if "1" is selected, a Case Manager must have at least 1 HIS assessment per month in order to be included)





Parameters: Payer Type

- This parameter can be used to indicate which payer group you would like to be included in the widget results
- By default, all payers are included






Adding a Preconfigured View



Adding the New Preconfigured Views

- Adding a new preconfigured view is a matter of just a few clicks
- Choose between the Hospice Scorecard view grouped by "Case Manager" or the Hospice Enterprise Scorecard view grouped by "Provider"





Drill Down for Individual Scorecards








The Provider Level Widget

- The Provider level view will allow you to see the performance of different locations within your enterprise
- This will be useful for organizations with more than one location on service with SHP
