

Criteria for Routine Home Care Level of Care

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General Considerations

The Routine Home Care (RHC) level of care is the most common level of hospice care. It is reimbursed at a daily rate for each day the patient is under the care of the hospice and not receiving one of the other levels of care. The payment for each day of RHC is made without regard to the volume or intensity of routine home care services provided on any given day.
