Instructions: May increase AST, ALT, GGT, CK and eosinophil count; Monitor for mental status changes, sedation, coma; Caution in elderly, caution in patients with heart disease, hypotension, seizures; Adverse effects: Somulence, Insomnia, Parkinsonism, Dizziness, Suicide attempt, Extrapyramidal events, Tachycardia, Chest pain, Constipation, Dry mouth, Hyperglycemia, Weight gain, Joint pain, Twitching, Injection site pain, Neuroleptic malignant syndrome.
