- Clients need to apply and be approved in order to use this service
- The cost is \$1 if it's in town and \$2 out of town each way.

- Provides transportation for senior citizens to local and out of town medical appointments, essential shopping, and social interaction when other means are either unavailable or unaffordable.
- Is a vital link in ensuring that older adults have access to needed services and opportunities.

- Clients are encouraged to make a donation.

- Provides non-emergency health care transportation for elderly and disabled persons in Eastern Massachusetts and Southern New Hampshire, including Boston hospitals and Lahey Clinic.
- Takes Medicaid
- \$50 round trip plus 75¢ per mile.
- Claim to be the most affordable wheelchair van service in the area
- Monday through Saturday.
- Clients need to call 2 or 3 days in advance
