M2420 D/C disposition: Where is the pt after discharge from your agency?

- 1-Patient remained in the community (without formal assistive services)
  - 2- Patient remained in the community (with formal assistive services)
  - 3-Patient transferred to a non-institutional hospice
  - 4- Unknown because patient moved to a geographic location not served by this agency
- UK- Other unknown

- Pts who are in assisted living or board and care housing are considered to be living in the community with formal assistive services.
- Formal assistive services refers to community-based services provided through organizations or by paid helpers (homemaking, Medicare waiver programs, PC provided by HHA, paid assistance Meal on Wheels)
- Informal services are provided by friends, family, neighbors, and others in the community that are not paid
- Noninstitutional hospice is defined as the patient receiving hospice care at home or a caregiver's home, not in an inpatient hospice facility.
